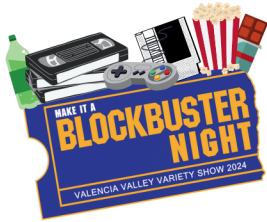

EMCEE AUDITION

Each audition is approximately 2 - 4 minutes, students may leave after they finished their audition. Applicants will be asked to recite their monologue and asked if they have any special talents (ie..singing, dancing, playing an instrument, juggling, tumbling, etc.)

EMCEE PRACTICE DAYS

Lunch Practices: Students that are selected to be an emcee will have script practice once a week, during lunch, beginning the week of January 29th. This will not overlap with student council. Weekly lunch practice day is TBD.

6th Grade Act Practices: Emcees will automatically be added to the 6th Grade Act performance and will need to practice on the following days after school from 3pm-5pm:

Jan 22, Jan 29, Feb 5, Feb 12, Feb 27

If your student is an emcee, but knows that they do not want to be in the 6th Grade Act please let us know so that we can plan accordingly.
